February 2022

1. Suspension of Face to Face Lessons

Owing to the worsening of the pandemic, the Education Bureau (EDB) has announced the class suspension began on 24th January. The suspension was extended after the Chinese New Year Holiday.

During the period of class suspension, our school provided online lessons to deliver online teaching to sustain students' learning. Students were required to submit their homework to their teachers. Teachers supervised and monitored their students' learning progress and homework submission.

2. The Fifth Meeting of the School Administration Committee

On 15th February, I chaired the meeting. We discussed the contingent arrangements for the activities after the Lunar New Year Holiday due to the possible prolonged period of suspension of face-to-face lessons afterward.

3. CCC Joint Schools Staff Development Day

On 18th February, all teachers participated in the CCC Joint Schools Staff Development development day. The theme of the day was 'The Value Education'.

The theme of the morning session was 'Value Education of the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China'(HKCCC). Rev. Wong Ka Fai, General Secretary of the HKCCC, gave a sharing on 'Our Philosophy and Christian Education'. Professor Wong Sing Wing Dennis, Practice and challenges faced by teachers"; the theme of the afternoon was "value education curriculum framework", the implementation of national education and national security education. Ms. Law Kit Ling Grace, Principal Education Officer (Curriculum Development) of the Curriculum Development Office of the Education Bureau, gave a lecture.

 - Build up a repository to store materials from Mathematics teachers of CCC secondary schools to facilitate sharing,
 - Invite all CCC secondary schools to participate in the “CCC Number Combination Competition 2023” organized by our school.
- (2) On 28th February, Mathematics Department organized a Post-Mock Examination of Mathematics Paper-II organized by Educational Publishing House to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with the question type of multiple-choice questions.
- (3) Students participated in the 2022 Big Bay Area Mathematical Hong Kong Selection Competition. The results were as follows:

- (4) Thirty students joined online tutorial groups organized by Canotta Publishing Company to provide them support for the Mock Examination of Mathematics.
