**June 2022**

**1. Students' Association Consultation Session and Election**

On 10 June, a Students' Association Consultation Session was held. The candidates were questioned from the present cabinet and the floor. There was one cabinet: "Twilight" participating in the election. On 14 June, the Students' Association Election was held. Every student could cast their vote for their favorite cabinet. Finally, the cabinet 'Twilight' was successfully elected.

**2. S.4 Students Presentation on the Outcomes of the Project Learning**

Under the "Optimized Arrangement of Core Subjects for Senior Secondary Schools" implemented by the Education Bureau in this school year, our school has designed our school-based curriculum to strengthen students' ability to carry out project learning aimed at caring for the needs of the elderly in the district with the integration of the knowledge they acquired so far. S.4 Students conducted project learning in groups, including collecting information on the needs of the elders in the district, conducting interviews with the elders, and analyzing their collected information, which help illustrate the needs of the elders. Then, using the conceptualization of "Design Thinking", they designed suitable solutions, which can be services or products, to meet the needs of the elders. On 10, 13, 14, 20, 21 and 22 June, each group reported their results to the principal, vice-principals and teachers during the lessons. The overall performance of each group is generally good, and individual groups have excellent performance. It is worth showing their results to the relevant government authorities, public organizations, or companies, so as to make some contributions to the improvement of services for the elderly.

On 25 June, the Department of Curriculum and Teaching, School of Education and Human Development, The Education University of Hong Kong, invited our teachers Li Wang Kin, Chan Tze Yung and Lam Ho Ka Jeremy to share their experience in using the Artificial Intelligence (AI) Learning Assessment and Practice System. In 2021 March, our school was invited by the Education University to jointly develop the system based on the concept of Adaptive Learning. We made a pilot practice in the subjects of Mathematics and Physics. Our school has uploaded a large number of questions to the system and tried it out in Secondary 5. It depicted good results. Our staff will continue to collaborate with EdUHK experts to optimize the system performance so as to provide more personalized opportunities for students to have more practice and help them improve.

## **10. Report from Subject Departments**

### **Mathematics Department**

- (1) On 14 June, S.2 STEM preparation meeting was held to confirm the rundown of the STEM activity. Mr. Li WK, Ms. Chu KM, Mr. Ma WL, Mr. Yu Jack, and Mr. Billy Ng attended the meeting.
- (2) The Mathematics Society is conducting the ‘Monthly Mathematics Challenge’ to arouse

students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for June were Hong King Hin (5E) and Tang Ching Nam (2E).

- (3) On 16 June, The Mathematics Department and the School Library jointly organized an online book sharing of Mathematics books for students. Three students (2C Lam Lok Yee, 2C Ngo Yan Hay, and 3C Lee Yiu Sing) shared their reading on the topic of 'Secret of Digits'. Ninety-five students joined the sharing.
- (4) From 23 - 28 June, S.2 STEM activities were held in the Mathematic lessons. Students learned how to solve the Trigonometry problems by coding in the microbit. They applied the concept of Pythagoras' Theorem and Trigonometry to solve problems to motivate students to learn Mathematics. Mr. Li WK, Ms. Chu KM, Mr. Ma WL, Mr. Yu Jack and Mr. Billy Ng were responsible for the STEM activities.
- (5) 3C Lee Yiu Sing represented our school to join the 'International Mathematical Olympiad Preliminary Selection Contest 2022' organized by the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education. He also received a merit prize from the 'National Mathematical Olympiad Hong Kong Preliminary Selection Contest 2022' for the competition.

A Pastel Nagomi Art Workshop was held on 21 June 2022 for the mentees of the scheme. The workshop aimed to help mentees build a sense of achievement and plan their revision for Final Term Examination. Nine S.1 – S.4 students participated, 5C Chau Cho Sin and 5D Li Hoi Fung helped tutor students to finish their artwork.
