1. The Special Staff Meeting

On 1 March, I chaired the Special Staff Meeting. We discussed the continued suspension of the face-to-face lessons, the arrangement of activities after March and the EDB policies on arrangements of special holidays after 14 March to 23 April, as well as other school routines.

2. Class Suspension and Arrangement of Special Holiday in March and April

Owing to the worsening of the pandemic, the Education Bureau (EDB) has announced the suspension of the face-to-face lessons that began on 24th January except for the class levels of students sitting for the public examinations this year. The Education Bureau (EDB) has announced that the summer holiday has been arranged in March and April as a Special Holiday. Our school started the Special Holiday on 14th March and ended on 23rd April.

3. S.1 Discretionary Places Selection Interview

Because of the worsening situation of the pandemic, the selection interview for 2022–2023 S1 Discretionary Place Admission of our school, scheduled on 19 March, was cancelled. The interviews were replaced by applicant submissions of their documents and video in both English and Cantonese.

6. Parents' Day

Because of the EDB's announcement regarding the class suspension, Parents' Day, scheduled on 26 March, was postponed from 1 to 3 April. Class teachers used Google Meet or phone calls to connect with S.1 to S.5 parents to discuss their children's academic and non-academic performance in the first term.

7. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) On 17, 23, 30 March and 6 April, S.6 online tutorials were held to help those students who need help. Nineteen students participated in the tutorials. Mr. Li WK and alumnus Wong Wai Nam were responsible for the tutorials.
- (2) The Mathematics Society of our school co-organized 'CCC Secondary Schools Digit Combination' with the Core Group of the Mathematics Teachers of CCC secondary schools. The participants will use the digits of 2,0,2,3 with various combinations, orders, symbols to arrange the number from 1 to 100. The deadline for the competition will be 15 April. The winners will represent our school to enter the final round of the competition with other CCC schools.
- (3) Our students participated in the Hong Kong International Olympiad First Round 2022 (Hong Kong Region) organized by Olympiad Champion Education Centre. 1D Tam Man Keng won the Golden Merit, 2A Lau Pak Hei and 3C Lee Yiu Sing won the Silver Merit.
- (4) The Mathematics Society organized an activity 'Monthly Mathematics Challenge' to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for March were Lee Yiu Sing (2A) and Wong King Hang (5F).
- (5) Professional Development Activities :
 - On 14 March, Mr. Li WK and Ms. Chu KM attended an online seminar "Gifted Education Curriculum Designing for Tier Three Mathematics" organized by Gifted Teachers Association.
