On 12 May, Dr. Maxwell Ho Chun Sing and the participants of the "Professional Development Program on School Improvement and Leadership" visited our school. This was organized by the Education University of Hong Kong. We discussed school organization as well as the Knowledge Management strategies. They were also escorted on a campus tour.

6. Report from Subject Departments
Mathematics Department
 - (1) On 23 May, S.2 Mathematics teachers held a meeting to discuss how to carry out STEM mathematics activities. Teachers included Mr. Li WK, Ms. Chu KM, Mr. Ma WL and Mr. Ng KM.
 - (2) Three Secondary 2 and Secondary 3 students (2C Lam Lok Yee, 2C Ngo Yan Hay and 3C Lee

Yiu Sing) participated in the Mathematics Reading Report Competition organized by the Education Bureau this month. The report was submitted to the Education Bureau on 18 May. This activity was in charge by Mr. Ng KM.

- (3) The Mathematical Society held a "Monthly Mathematics Challenge" activity to enhance students' interest in mathematics. The winners of this month are 1C Chen Zhi Hui and 3D Chow Mei Sze.
- (4) On 25 May, the Mathematical Society published 'Mathgazine' for students to inspire students' interest in mathematics. This issue introduced Gauss, the great mathematician and also trigonometric functions and π (pie) story.
- (5) On 27 May, the Mathematical Society held 'MATHSWALK'. Sixty-seven students from Secondary 2 to Secondary 5 participated in this activity. In this activity, groups of four were used to solve different types of mathematics problems and improve students' understanding of mathematics.
- (6) Others
 - Due to the impact of the epidemic, the Hong Kong Polytechnic University decided to cancel the joint-districts prize-giving ceremony of the 15th Hong Kong Primary School Mathematics Competition this year. All trophies, shields and medals will be distributed to the winning schools in the district through our school. The details have also been uploaded to our school website for the award-winning schools.
 - The Education University of Hong Kong has designed a new learning assessment system for our school with Artificial Intelligence (AI) technologies. The system has been tried out for S.5 students this month. We hope that we can make suggestions for improvement as soon as possible after the trial.

Chemistry Department

- (1) On 7th May, two S.3 students participated in the "Hong Kong Geologist's View on Local Prehistoric Artefacts" Lecture organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.

- (2) 5C Hong Tze Hei has won the 2nd runner up in Boys U18 110m hurdle in Hong Kong Athletics 2022 - Series 1 and 2nd runner up in U20 110m hurdle in Hong Kong Athletics 2022 - Series 2 organized by Hong Kong Association of Athletics Affiliates.

Visual Arts Department

- (1) S.3 student Yeung Man Yat obtained the second runner up of "World Heart Day Drawing Competition", organized by Hong Kong College of Cardiology.
- (2) S.4 student Cheng Ho Lai took part in the art tour to Po Toi Island on 29-5-2022. He obtained some drawing skills during the tour and understood more the nature beauty to inspire his drawing for the competition.
- (3) Over sixty students of 3B and 3D had a chance to learn ceramics, Mr. Law Hon Wah, an experienced artist came to school for teaching students ceramic arts. It is good to expose students to different mediums of art.

7. Report from The Academic Affairs Committee

To optimize our school's senior secondary (SS) elective subject curriculum and to familiarize students with the elective subject selection procedure, a trial practice has been held for S.3 students in April. The selection results have been announced in the class-based Google Classroom on 16 May 2022 (Monday). Considering of students' choices collected from the trial practice, the S4 elective subject blockings for 2022 – 2023 are finalized.

On 27 May 2022 (Friday), all S.3 students were informed of the finalized SS class structure and elective subject combinations in a talk. On the same day, the elective subject selection form was posted in the form-based Google Classroom. The form submission deadline and result release date will be 1 August 2022 (Monday) and 12 August 2022 (Friday) respectively.

8. Report from School Library

On 20 May, an author talk was successfully held. A famous author, Ms. Shirely Loo, shared the topic 'How reading helps us overcome adversity' with our students and teachers. After the talk, a gathering of "Meet-the-Author" was held. Nine S.4 & S.5 students shared their reading reflection and conducted a very fruitful dialogue with Ms. Shirely Loo.
