**Monthly School Report**  
**September 2021**

**1. New School Year Opening Ceremony**

The 2021–2022 academic year started on 1st September. Owing to the impact of COVID-19, our school held the ceremony using a blended mode to encourage students to remain optimistic in this difficult time.

**2. The First Meeting of the School Administration Committee**

On 6th September, I chaired the meeting of the School Administration Committee. We discussed the arrangements for half-day lessons and the revision of the repeating policy.

**3. Meeting of the Golden Jubilee Organising Committee**

On 7th September, I chaired the meeting of the School Anniversary Organizing Committee to discuss the launching of activities for our school's 50th anniversary.

**4. Meeting with the New Supervisor Dr. Kao Yi Tsun Richard**

On 9th September, the new Supervisor Dr. Kao Yi Tsun Richard visited our school and met with the vice-principals and me. The Supervisor listened to our report on our school's status quo and future development.

**5. Meeting with the New Educational Psychologist Dr. Kitty Yeung**

On 17 September, the new Educational Psychologist Dr. Kitty Yeung visited our school and met with Mr. Moy KY, the Vice-principal, Ms. Ng Tsz Yan, the Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO) and me. We discussed the working plan for this academic year.

**6. Student Leaders Inauguration Ceremony**

On the afternoon of 17th September, the Student Leaders Inauguration Ceremony was held online. I gave a speech to encourage our student leaders to serve their fellow schoolmates and reminded them to strike a balance between organizing activities and studies.

**7. Report from Subject Departments**

**Mathematics Department**

- (1) The Mathematics Enrichment Course for S.5 and S.6 students were held beginning from this month. The course was designed for the participants to improve their Mathematics academic results. There are seven S.5 students and thirteen S.6 students voluntarily joined the course. Mr. Li Shing Foon was responsible for the course.
- (2) On 27 September, the Mathematics Society organised a Mathematics Origami activity

on online platform to provide opportunity for students to appreciate the wonders of the Geometry. There were one hundred eighty-one students participating in the activity..

- (3) On 30 September, the Mathematics Department organized a training course for drilling Mathematics Multiple Choice Questions for S.6 students. Mr. Wong Chun Tat, the Vice-Principal, Mr. Li Wang Kin, the Mathematics Department Head, Mr. Tai Tze Tik, and Mr. Lam Ho Ka were responsible for the course.
- (4) The Mathematics Department has recruited students to participate in the Olympic Mathematics Training Courses. Seventeen S.1 students, fourteen S.2 students, eight S.3 students, fourteen S.4 students joined the courses. The course has been started on 28 September, Ms. Chu Ka Man and Mr. Tai Tze Tik were responsible for the courses. Mr. Li Wang Kin was responsible for recruiting another group of S.2 and S.3 students to participate in the Pan-Asia Mathematics Competition.

### **Chemistry Department (Science KLA)**

- (1) Two gifted S.4 and S.5 science students were nominated to participate in the “Pilot Scheme for Secondary Schools – Dual Program” organized by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology with the aid of “Diversity Learning Grant”.
- (2) Eighty-three S.5 and S.6 Chemistry students participated in the “Chemists Online Self-study Award Scheme (COSAS)” organized by the Hong Kong Virtual University.

- (3) With the aids of the “Diversity Learning Grant”, forty-four S.6 Chemistry students were nominated to join the “HKDSE Chemistry Mock Examination” organized by the Hong Kong Association of Mathematics and Science Education.
- (4) On 21st September, one S5 Chemistry student participated in the “Popular Science Workshop 2021 (September)” organised by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology.
- (5) On 24th September, one team of four S5 Chemistry students participated in the “Building Safety Student Ambassador Program – Cement making challenge (Final Round)” organised by the Hong Kong Building Department.
- (6) On 25th September, seventeen S3 to S5 Chemistry students participated in the “Physics and Maths in Animation Creation” online seminar organised by the Hong Kong Science Museum.
- (7) A team of five F.3 students was nominated to join the “International Junior Science Olympiad” Competition organised by the Hong Kong Education Bureau. A written test was held on 26th September 2021 at Cheung Sha Wan Catholic Secondary School.
- (8) Remedial classes for S6 students were arranged in this month. Discussion on common mistakes in online MC assignments and revision tests on previous topics have been conducted through Google Meet.
- (9) With the support of the “Diversity Learning Grant”, enrichment classes were arranged

for S6 Chemistry students through Google Meet. We hope that they can get better results in the coming HKDSE examinations.

### **Integrated Science Department**

On 25th September, eleven S.1 and S.2 students participated in the “Physics and Maths in Animation Creation” online seminar organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.

### **Physical Education Department**

- (1) 4E Cheung Ming Hung, 4C Hong Tze Hei and 3D Lee Sze Yeung were selected to join the athletic team of South China Athletic Association.
- (2) 4C Kwok Hiu Kin and 3D Lee Sze Yeung were selected to join the Hong Kong volleyball junior team.

## **8. Report from the Academic Affairs Committee**

- (1) The grace period for S.4 students was from 3 September to 10 September this year. After the grace period, five students had applied to change their elective subjects. None student changed their elective subjects successfully.
- (2) A brief talk concerning the Homework Submission Policy was held for S.1 students on 1 September. An online briefing for S.1 – S.2 subject monitors was held between 8 September to 11 September. The Homework Submission Policy was launched on 16 September for this academic year.
- (3) The debriefing session for the Summer School, Edutopia, was held on 8 September afternoon. Participating students reviewed and reflected their learning outcome in Edutopia.
- (4) Several new school-based curricula are developed in this academic year. They are S.2 STEAM, S.4 Humanistic Education as well as S.4 Language Across the Curriculum. The curricula have kick started smoothly.

## **9. Report from the Discipline Committee**

On 17th September, the Inauguration Ceremony was held for our school leaders, including the Prefects Team.

## **10. Report from the Extra-Curricular Affairs Committee**

- The recruitment of members of interest clubs and interest classes was completed.
- There were seven interest clubs and seven interest classes.
- Lessons of interest classes were started in late September.

## **11. Report from the Religious Education Committee**

- (1) On 18th September, the Education Service was held. Teachers of Religious Education Committee and S.1 students attended the Teenager Service of Heep Woh Church at the school hall. Twenty-four S.1 students were willing to commit to Jesus.
- (2) On 29th September after school, the online Christian Fellowship was organized.

Christian Fellowship adopts “Fruit of the Holy Spirit” as the theme of the year. It aimed to encourage our students to know the love of God more.

- (3) On 14th and 20th September, meetings of the core group of Christian Fellowship were held preparing for the Student Fellowship activities.

## **12. Parental Affairs Committee**

- (1) On 3rd September, the 8th committee meeting of 22nd PTA Executive Committee was held. The main agenda of the meeting includes discussing the details of the PTA AGM and the annual report of 2020-2021 school year.
- (2) In September, the “23rd PTA Committee Election” & “6th Parent Manager Election” was held by the PTA. On 24th September, the Voting Day of “23rd PTA Committee Election” & “6th Parent Manager Election” was held smoothly. For the “23rd PTA Committee Election”, 10 parents were elected as members of the PTA Executive Committee. For the “6th Parent Manager Election”, Ms Ko Hiu Tung, Jessica and Ms Ng Yan Han were elected as parent manager and alternate parent manager respectively.
- (3) In September, the PTA magazine was published. It summarized the activities held by the PTA in 2020-2021 school year.
