Monthly School Report
December 2022

1. Invitation to talk to the Parents and Students of Tsz Wan Shan St. Bonaventure Catholic Primary School

On 2nd December, I was invited to give a talk to the parents and students of Tsz Wan Shan St. Bonaventure Catholic Primary School to introduce our school. Approximately 200 parents and students attended the talk.

2. School Information Day

On 3rd December, our school organized the Information Day with a blended mode. Our school used face-to-face talks and an online platform to deliver information about S.1 admission for our prospective students and their parents to understand our school policies.

3. Third Staff Meeting

On 7th December, I chaired the third Staff Meeting. We discussed the possibility of issuing a letter of school leaving certificate for certain students in the next academic year, S.6 Post-mock tutorial coordination, Jockey Club e-reading scheme, the arrangements for the Athletic Meet, Christmas Service and Celebration and other school routines.

4. Invitation to talk to the Parents and Students of CCC Kei Tsz Primary School

On the afternoon of 7th December, I was invited to give a talk to the parents and students of CCC Kei Tsz Primary School to introduce our school. Approximately 100 parents and students attended the talk.

5. The 47th Athletic Meet

On 8th and 9th December, the 47th Athletic Meet was held at Hammer Hill Sports Ground. At the Opening Ceremony, I relayed to the students how an Athletic Meet was a way of learning. Mr. Wong Kam Po, an outstanding racing cyclist and a world champion in UCI Track Cycling World Cup in 2007, was invited to be our honorable guest to present prizes in the ceremony. He used his story to encourage our students to strive for excellence.

6. Wong Tai Sin Joint Primary School Mathematics Competition

On 10th December, our school organized the Wong Tai Sin Joint Primary School Mathematics Competition. 176 students from eighteen primary schools participated in this competition. The competition aimed to test participants' reasoning power, problem-solving abilities and collaboration skills.

7. Invitation to talk to the Parents and Students of Canossa Primary School

On 10th December, Ms. Lin SY, two S.1 students graduated from Canossa Primary School and I were invited to give a talk to the parents and students of Canossa Primary School to introduce our school. Approximately 300 parents and students attended the talk.

8. School Tour for CCC Primary Schools

On the afternoon of 10th December, our school arranged the school tour for three CCC primary schools in the district. Our school delivered information about the S.1 admission for CCC primary school students and their parents to understand our school policies and arranged a campus tour to several school facilities.

9. Christmas Concert

After school on 15th December, the Music Department organized a “Christmas Concert” in the School Hall. Approximately 280 students and teachers attended the concert.

10. Inter-class Rope-skipping Competition and fund raising programme

On the afternoon of 16th December, our school organized a popular event — the Rope-skipping Competition—to raise funds for the Jump Rope for Heart Program (JRFH). Our school has held the event for sixteen years. The mission of JRFH is to motivate our young generations to develop a healthy lifestyle through exercise, thus reducing the risk of heart disease and stroke. Each class had their team participate in the competition and made a great effort practicing beforehand.

11. Invitation to talk to the Parents and Students of CCC Kei Wa Primary School

On the afternoon of 17th December, I was invited to give a talk to the parents and students of CCC Kei Wa Primary School to introduce our school. Approximately 200 parents and students attended the talk.

12. Christmas Celebration and Class Party

On 20th December, our school organized the Christmas Service and class parties. We invited Life Kindling Creative Worship School sang hymns to lead our students to worship God and shared message about the meaning of Christmas. After this, there were class parties. Students enjoyed these two functions.

13. “Heep Woh’s Singing Contest”

On 20th December, the Students’ Association (SA) organized Heep Woh’s Singing Contest, a traditional event in HWC. The event comprised individual and group competitions. Students participated in the event actively.

14. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) On 5th and 12th December, the Department organized tutorials for S.1 low achievers to help them consolidate their learning. Mr. Li WK and Mr. Siu King San (the student teacher) were responsible for the tutorials, and Mathematics Buddies offered assistance to the participants.
- (2) On 10th December, the Department organized a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics in Paper II (Multiple Choice) for S.6 students so as to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various question types.
- (3) On 10th December, our school organized the Wong Tai Sin Joint Primary School Mathematics Competition. About one hundred students from eighteen primary schools participated in the competition. The competition aimed to test participants' reasoning power, problem-solving abilities and collaboration skills.
- (4) On 15th December, Mr. Li WK and Mr. Lam HK from the Mathematics Department and Mr. Chan TY from the Physics Department had an online meeting with the Education University of Hong Kong to discuss the fine-tuning of the AI Assessment System.
- (5) On 18th December, our students were awarded in the first-round competition of Pan-Asia Pacific International Mathematics Competition: First Merit (3D Li Tsz San, 3C Wong Yu Hong). Second Merit (2A Tse Tin Sum, 2A Lam Ka Ying, 2C Mak Cheuk Man, 1A Kwan Chi Hei and 1B Ng Keng Chin).
- (6) On 23rd December, ninety-seven S.6 students joined a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics organized by Canotta Publishing Company so as to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various question types. Moreover, twenty-one students from S.6E joined a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics Extended Module M2 on 30 December.

About two hundred and sixty students, including performers and audience, attended this event to celebrate the festive joy with music and caroling.

Physical Education Department

- (1) On 8th and 9th December, the 47th Athletic Meet was held. Lowrey House was the overall champion and two individual records were broken.
- (2) On 16th December, the Inter-class Rope Skipping Competition was held. During the competition, joy and cheers resounded through the school. 5E was the overall champion. They skipped the rope with one hundred and twenty-seven times in two minutes.
