1. Full Resumption of Whole-Day Face-to-face Lessons

The Education Bureau (EDB) has announced the full resumption of whole-day face-to-face lessons that began on 1st February. After the Chinese New Year Holiday, our school resumed normally. Students could stay at school to get along with their schoolmates and their teachers. Teachers supervised and monitored their students' learning progress and homework submission.

2. Social Worker Performance Appraisal Half-Yearly Review

On 9th February, Ms. Chung Wai Yin Ivy, the Supervisor of the School Social Worker with social workers Ms. Yu Sze Nga Celia, Ms. Wong Foo Yan Joyce, Ms. Cheung Hiu Tung Gloria and Mr. Ip Yee Ho Gary had a meeting with Mr. Wong Chun Tat, Vice-principal, Mr. Kwan Chi Ho, Guidance Master, Mr. Leung Wing Fai, the Career Master, Ms. Au Hau Yi, Discipline Mistress, Ms. Man Sau Chu, the Chairlady of the Parents Affairs Committee and me to evaluate our school social workers' performance in the first term and discuss the program plan for the second term.

3. Farewell to Graduates Assembly

On 10th February, a Farewell to Graduates Assembly was held. Videos produced by S6 graduates were presented. They made use of this opportunity to show their gratitude to the teachers and the school. Teachers sang the song "Years Like Song" to the graduates to give blessings to them.

4. EDB Focus Inspection of Technology KLA

On 15th, 16th, 20th and 22nd February, Quality Assurance Officers from the Education Bureau (EDB) conducted a focus inspection of the Key Learning Area of Technology Education (TE). The officers conducted lesson observation and examined our school documents to provide professional views and feedback. EDB gathered evidence to understand the school's progress in implementing the relevant curriculum and education policies.

5. S.4 Life Education Camp

From 22nd to 24th February, the Life Education Committee organized a Life Education Camp for S.4 students to help them adapt to the changes in the senior secondary school curriculum and set up their own life goals. The camp used a series of programmes including talks, simulation games, adventure-based activities and discussions to help students think about the orientation of their future. This is the first time our school has organized a camp for S.4 students. Our school will evaluate the effectiveness of the camp.

6. S.1 & S.2 Parents' Night

On the evening of 24th February, the Guidance Committee and school social workers organized a forum for S.1 & S.2 parents. Mr. Kwan Chi Ho, the Guidance Master, shared some tips to help parents understand how to help parents face their children's difficulties in their academic progress.

7. HKCCCC Joint Secondary School Art Exhibition 2015 - Muses of Arts

From 24th to 27th February, our school co-organized HKCCCC Joint Secondary School Art Exhibition 2023 - 'Muses of Arts' with other CCC Secondary Schools. On 25th February afternoon, an opening ceremony was held at the Y-Studio of the Youth Square.

8. The Fifth Meeting of the School Administration Committee

On 28th February, I chaired the meeting. We discussed the results of surveys, such as the Stakeholders Survey, APASO, and School-based questionnaires.

9. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) Our school has developed a system for Assessment for Learning with the aid of Artificial Intelligence with the Education University of Hong Kong. We have launched the platform with the function for the Assessment for Learning for our S.4 and S.5 students to enhance their consolidation of knowledge and skills. We will solicit the views from teachers and students to further improve the functionality of the system.
- (2) On 15th February, the Mathematics Society organized a RUMMIKUB competition for our students. Fifty-six S.1 - S.5 students actively joined the competition. The winners were 3A Lau Suet Yan, 3A Ching Yat Fei, 1C Tsui Yiu Chun and 5C Cheung Tsz Ching. They will represent our school to participate in the CCC Secondary Schools RUMMIKUB competition 2023.
- (3) On 21st February, Mr. Li WK, the Mathematics Department Head, met with the representatives from the Youth College of Kowloon Bay of Vocational Training Council to discuss the collaboration to apply for Quality Education Fund with a programme 'Apply Blended Learning with Educational Card Game on Mathematics'.
