## 9. Report from Subject Departments

### Mathematics Department

- (1) On 28<sup>th</sup> March, Our Department and the Physics Department discussed with the representatives from the Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) for reviewing the system for Assessment for Learning and the plan. Mr. Li WK, Mr. Chan TY and Mr. Lam HK joined the discussion.
- (2) S.6 Mathematics tutorial classes were held for students. Thirty-five S.6 students were recruited. Mr. Li WK and Mr. Lam HK were responsible for teaching the tutorial classes.
- (3) On 1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> March after school, S.4 remedial classes were held. The alumni Lai Tsz On and Chan Ki Hin were the instructors for the classes.
- (4) S.1-3 Mathematics tutorial classes were held for students every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday in March. Sixty one S.1 -S.3 students were recruited. Mr. Li WK organized the classes, Ms. Ng MW, Ms. Chan ST, Mr. Lam HK, Mr. Tai TT, Ms. Chu KM, Mr. Ng KM and S.5 Maths. Buddies were responsible for teaching the tutorial classes.

### **Economics Department (PSHE KLA)**

(1) On 17th March, eleven S5 students attended Budget ONLINE@M21 organised by the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups. The activity provides a great chance for the students to review the Budget and express their opinion to the Financial Secretary of Hong Kong, Mr Paul Chan Mo-po.

(2) On 17th March, our department invited Ms. Gentiana Cheung (Professional Consultant Director, BBA in Hospitality and Real Estate Programme) from the Chinese University of Hong Kong Business School to deliver a lecture on ‘Virtual Reality (VR) in daily life - with VR Headsets experience’. The lecture attracted fourteen S.4 Economists and ten S.5 Economists to attend.

### **Music Department**

(1) On 9th March, more than 200 students attended a lunchtime concert held in the school hall. The theme of the concert was “Salute the Spring”. Programmes included a guzheng solo, yangqin solo and drum solo. The highlight of the concert was the performance of the School's Chinese Orchestra.

(2) To nurture a life-long interest in performing arts appreciation, students were encouraged to attend concerts and performances outside the school. On 25<sup>th</sup> March, sixty students from S3 to S5 participated in the International A cappella Extravaganza 2023 organized by the HK Federation of Youth Groups. Students were fully engaged and had an enjoyable artistic learning experience.

### **Visual Arts Department**

(1) Eighteen senior form VA students attended the 2022-2023 Jockey Club ICH Innovative Heritage Education Programme “Pass it on @ Secondary” course (Cheong Sam Sewing Technique), organized by Lingnan University. Three students got a Distinction; Eleven students got a Merit.

(2) On 2nd March, seven S5 VA students and Mr. Wan visited Hong Kong Palace Museum.

It was an eye-opening experience to see many precious artworks and also to know the art history and culture of our nation. It was a valuable experience and student tickets were sponsored by the museum.

- (3) Mr. Wan arranged four supplementary lessons for S6 VA students for art knowledge consolidation and answering examination skills in March 2023.

### **PE Department**

- (1) On 15th February, the Hong Kong Youths Unified Association organized three ‘Air Storm’ introductory courses for our students. A total of 189 (F.2 – F.4) students attended the course. After getting a taste of this new sport, most of them showed interest in it.
- (2) Our table tennis team participated in a friendly match with TWGHs Wong Fut Nam College on 8 March. All our Boys B&C team and Girls B team won the championships.
- (3) On 18th March, 3B Jiang Yuk Chun won the championship in the Boys C grade high jump in the Hong Kong TCAA Athletics Championships (Round 1) with his new personal best of 1.80m.

## **10. Report from Academic Affairs Committee**

- (1) To help S3 students in senior secondary (SS) elective subject selection, videos were produced by department heads to introduce the curriculum of each SS elective subject. Video links were shared with S3 students in March.
- (2) A trial practice for senior secondary elective subject selection was conducted for S3 students from 6<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> March. Students and their parents were informed about the arrangement through eNotice sent on 6<sup>th</sup> March. Students were requested to submit the subject selection Google Form via Google Classroom. The selection result was released on 31<sup>st</sup> March.
