1. New School Year Opening Ceremony

The 2022-2023 academic year started on 1st September. All teachers and students attended the ceremony with excitement and happiness. Our alumnus, Mr. Kwan Chuk Fai, who is a successful businessman, gave a speech. Mr. Kwan served as a Director of Hang Lung Properties before his retirement. He had served in senior management positions in different organizations including the Independent Commission Against Corruption, Cathay Pacific Airways, New World First Bus, and New World Group. Mr. Kwan is currently a member of the Steering Committee on Promotion of Volunteer Service and the Chairman of the Community Investment and Inclusion Fund Committee (Labour and Welfare Bureau). 6. CCC New Teacher Forum

On 24th September, newly appointed teachers Mr. Cheung Kit, Mr. Ho Ka Chun, Mr. Lui Charlz Chak Kwan, Ms. Ng Man Wai, Ms. Tang Kai Wing Cheryl, Mr. Tang Siu Fung Eric, Ms. Yau Yee Yeung and I attended a forum to learn more about our school sponsoring body – The Church of Christ in China, Hong Kong Council. We also talked with Dr. Kao Yi Tsun, the Supervisor of our school, about life at our school.

7. S.1 Parents' Night

On the evening of 30th September, the Guidance Committee and school social workers organized a forum for S.1 parents. Mr. Kwan Chi Ho, the Guidance Master, shared some tips to help parents understand how to help their children adapt to the transition from primary school to secondary school.

8. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) S.5 Remedial Class was held this month to help the low achievers consolidate their learning. Mr. Lee SF was in charge of the class.
- (2) 4D Cheng Wing Yan won the Second Class Merit and 5E Lai Tik San won the Third Class Merit in the 39th Hong Kong Mathematics Olympiad organized by the Education Bureau and the Department of Mathematics and Information Technology of The Education University of Hong Kong.
- (3) The recruitment of members of Olympic Mathematics Training for both junior and senior forms students continues. Thirteen S.1 students, twelve S.2 students and S.3 students, were enrolled and twelve S.2 students were recruited to an advanced learners group. Ms. Chu Ka Man and Mr. Tai Tze Tik were in charge of the training.
- (4) On 16th September, Mr. Li Wang Kin, the Mathematics Department Head, and Mr. Ma Wai Lam participated in the first Preparation Meeting for the “Hong Kong Primary School Mathematics Contest” discussing the workflow of the Contest.

Chemistry Department (Science KLA)

- (1) Five S.4 gifted science students were nominated to participate in the “Pilot Scheme for Secondary Schools – Dual Program” organized by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology with the aid of “The Diversity Learning Grant”.
- (2) Fifty-two S.5 and S.6 Chemistry students participated in the “Chemists Online Self-study Award Scheme (COSAS)” organized by the Hong Kong Virtual University. They got excellent results:

- (6) On 15th September, twenty-seven S3 to S5 Chemistry students participated in the “The Big 8 Dinosaur Revelation” seminar organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.
- (7) On 24th September, twelve S3 to S5 Chemistry students participated in the “The Hong Kong Jockey Club Series: Science in Art Scientist Sharing Sessions – Coral Mom” seminar organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.
- (8) On 24th September, eighteen S3 to S5 Chemistry students participated in the “The Hong Kong Jockey Club Series: Science in Art Scientist Sharing Sessions – Nature Knows the Mathematics” seminar organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.
- (9) A team of six F.3 students was nominated to join the “International Junior Science Olympiad” Competition organized by the Hong Kong Education Bureau. A written test was held on 25th September 2022 at the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
- (10) On 30th September, two S4 Chemistry students participated in the “OSH 4-Panel Comic Drawing Competition 2022” organized by the Hong Kong Occupational Safety & Health Council.
- (11) Professional Development Activity :
On 28th September, our laboratory technicians held a Community of Practice for our science teachers on the topic of “Use of the Fire Extinguishing Facilities in Science Laboratories”.
