Report on the Use of the Promotion of Reading Grant for 2023-2024

Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness

1. Evaluation of achievement of the objectives:

In the 2023-2024 school year, a total of 4,057 books were borrowed, which is comparable to the 4,199 borrowed in the previous year. Notably, 46.8% of students reported spending over one hour per week reading online materials. Furthermore, the stakeholder survey indicated an increase in the statement "我經常在課餘閱讀課外讀物," with scores rising from 3.18 to 3.26, demonstrating a positive trend in students' reading habits. Additionally, 16 students were recognized in the F1 to F2 Reading Award Scheme for their outstanding reading achievements.

2. Evaluation of strategies:

This school year, F3 Class Libraries were established, complementing the F1 and F2 Class Libraries set up in previous years, allowing all junior students to borrow books during the reading sessions on Monday and Wednesday mornings.

To foster a school-wide reading culture, various reading activities were organized in collaboration with other departments. Significant initiatives included Godspel Week Book Fair co-hosted with the Religious Education Committee, as well as Book Sharing activities in partnership with the Mathematics Department. Other collaborative events included the "篇篇流螢『全年之星』" and "文言閱讀報告比賽" with the Chinese Language Department, along with the "ERS Outstanding Students Award" organized with the English Language Department. Furthermore, 20 teachers participated in AAC centralised book sharing session during morning assembly.

To further enrich students' understanding of VE, NE and NSE, three themed book displays focusing on "Perseverance", the "May Fourth Movement" and "24 Solar Terms" were organized.
