8. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) On 2nd November, a meeting was held for the forthcoming Joint Primary School Mathematics Competition. The competition was scheduled on 11th December.
- (2) The Mathematics Society organized an activity 'Monthly Mathematics Challenge' to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for November were Wong Yeuk Hei (1D) and Cheng Wing Yan (3A).
- (3) On 4th November, a lesson for training skills for Multiple Choice Questions for S.6 students was held. Mr. Wong Chun Tat, the Vice-Principal, Mr. Li Wang Kin, Mr. Tai Tze Tik and Mr. Lam Ho Ka were responsible for training the students.
- (4) On 8th November, Mathematics Club and Science Club jointly organized an activity STRAWSCRAPER by using theory of Trigonometry to understand the building structure and constructing models by straws. Sixty-five students joined the activity.
