## 6. Report from Subject Departments

### **Mathematics Department**

- (1) On 5, 19 & 26 October, Mathematics Olympic Training Classes for junior and senior form students started in October. Ms. Chu Ka Man and Mr. Tai Tze Tik were the coordinators.
- (2) From October onwards, the Mathematics Society is conducting the ‘Monthly Mathematics Challenge’ to arouse students’ interest in Mathematics. The winners for October were Mak Cheuk Man (1A) and Cheng Wing Yan (3A).
- (3) On 27 October, the Mathematics Society published *Mathgazine* and distributed it to all students to promote their interests in learning Mathematics. The current issue included a story of a Mathematician, DSE learning tips and interesting Mathematics problems.
- (4) Others
  - To equip students with relevant skills and knowledge to sit for the HKDSE, the Mathematics Department helped S.6 students order the Mathematics Mock Examination Paper.

### **Chemistry Department (Science KLA)**

- (1) Remedial Classes for S.6 students were arranged this month. Discussion on common mistakes on online MC assignments and revision tests on the previous topics have been conducted through Google Meet.
- (2) With the aids of the “Diversity Learning Grant”, enrichment classes were arranged for S.6 Chemistry students through Google Meet. We hope that they can receive better results on the upcoming HKDSE examinations.
- (3) Eight S.5 Science students were divided into two teams, were accepted to join the “Hong Kong Secondary Students Chinese Medicine Quiz Competition” organized by the Hong Kong Baptist University.
- (4) Eight S5 Science students divided into two teams were nominated to join the “Energy Innovation” Competition organized by the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers and the Hong Kong China Light and Power.
- (5) A team of five S.3 students participated in the “International Junior Science Olympiad” Competition organized by the Hong Kong Education Bureau. They got two Third Class Honour.
- (6) Five S.3 to S.5 Chemistry students participated in the “Popular Science Workshop 2021 (Oct)” organized by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology.
- (7) Ten S.4 and S.5 Chemistry students were nominated to join the “Hong Kong Brain Bee Competition” organized by the Hong Kong Brain Foundation.

- (8) Three S.3 to S.5 students participated in the “GIRLS GO TECH STEM” learning programme organized by the Hong Kong Women’s Foundation.
- (9) One team of four S.4 students participated in the “Energy Community 2030” organized by the Energy Institute of Hong Kong. They won the Second Runner-up in the Senior Secondary Division.
- (10) On 7 October, nine S.3 to S.5 Science students participated in the “Science Online Tour @ The Science Behind Pixar” online seminar organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.
- (11) On 9 October, twenty-six S3 to S5 Science students participated in the “Into the Mysteries of Stars” online seminar organized by the Hong Kong Space Museum.

### **Music Department**

- (1) Four Music School teams, including the Chinese Orchestra, Western Orchestra, junior choir and senior choir have started online rehearsals since October. The total number of members is about a hundred.
- (2) The following musical instrument classes have started tuition since October. Both online and face-to-face modes have been arranged for different classes. Face-to-face lessons have been arranged for violin, guzheng and dizi classes. Guitar, flute, saxophone, clarinet and pipa classes have adopted online mode The total number of participants is eighty-eight.
- (3) Supplementary e-learning materials have been used as an enhancement for Face to face formal music lessons. This blended learning mode encourages students to take responsibility for their learning outside the classroom.

## 9. Report from the Academic Affairs Committee

- (1) The Life-wide Learning Day originally scheduled on 13 October 2021 (Wednesday) was cancelled due to the hoisting of typhoon signal number 8.
- (2) The senior secondary (SS) curriculum and elective subject selection talk for S3 parents was successfully held online on 22 October 2021 (Friday). The SS curriculum, the elective subject combination and the subject selection mechanism were introduced to parents.

## 10. Report from the Discipline Committee

On 15th October, a mini-talk about the school rules and setting class rules was organized by the Prefects Team. A short video about school rules was tailor-made by them to introduce the topic to the S.1 students.

#### 11. Report from the Career Guidance Committee

- (1) On 4 October, students submitted their information to the JUPAS system. S.6 students were accompanied to the Computer Laboratory to open their JUPAS system account.
- (2) In mid-October, students were allocated to one of twenty teachers as their mentors to advise them about their study pathway.
- (3) On 15 October, the mock release of HKDSE results was held for S.6 students. This will help them prepare for their future. There were opportunities for students to consult teachers and social workers about the planning of their future studies.
- (4) An information package on Multiple Pathways for S.6 students was prepared. S.6 class teacher used this package to introduce information on career and further study to parents.

- (1) On 9th October, an election for posts among the PTA committee members was held via Google Meet. After that, a meeting for the committee members was held so that they can know more about the PTA before the PTA AGM.
